NEW UPDATE FORM THE PROVINCE

1. 'Risk Assessment Team' was formed incorporating vital members from diversified scopes for:
 - Hospital Preparation and Clinical Management Assessment and
 - Quarantine and Isolation Service Evaluation
2. Health & Nutrition Clusters were formed and activated.
3. First meeting of Health and Nutrition clusters was conducted on 29 April 2020

ISSUES/NEEDS

1. Supply of logistics should be flowed in “One Loop System”
2. Issues due to the scarcity of resources like; personal protective equipment (PPE), Nutrition supplements and Vitamin A supplies, there are challenges in conducting regular activities in birthing centers, healthcare services, and immunization programs.
3. It was found that most of the quarantines have not been set up according to the National guidelines.
4. Sanitizer tunnels? – Do these following any guidelines?
5. Health worker safety and capacity building training to health workers in response to COVID-19

ANY INNOVATIVE APPROACHES IN THE PROVINCIAL RESPONSE TO COVID-19

1. Regular monitoring quarantine settings
2. Formation of risk assessment team and its activation is on next priority
3. A building (prefabricated) was constructed at Timure rural village of Rasuwa District
4. Potential Action plans for COVID-19 response were prepared and implemented
5. Budget was distributed through MoSD to provincial and local governments to combat COVID-19
