




COVID 19 AFFECTED DISTRICTS


District wise distribution of COVID-19 active cases




COVID-19 Summary (Last 24 hours)

SEX WISE DISTRIBUTION OF COVID-19 CASES (TOTAL=14046)




COVID-19 Cases details (Cumulative):



- A number of radio/television interviews, news paper articles have been published




