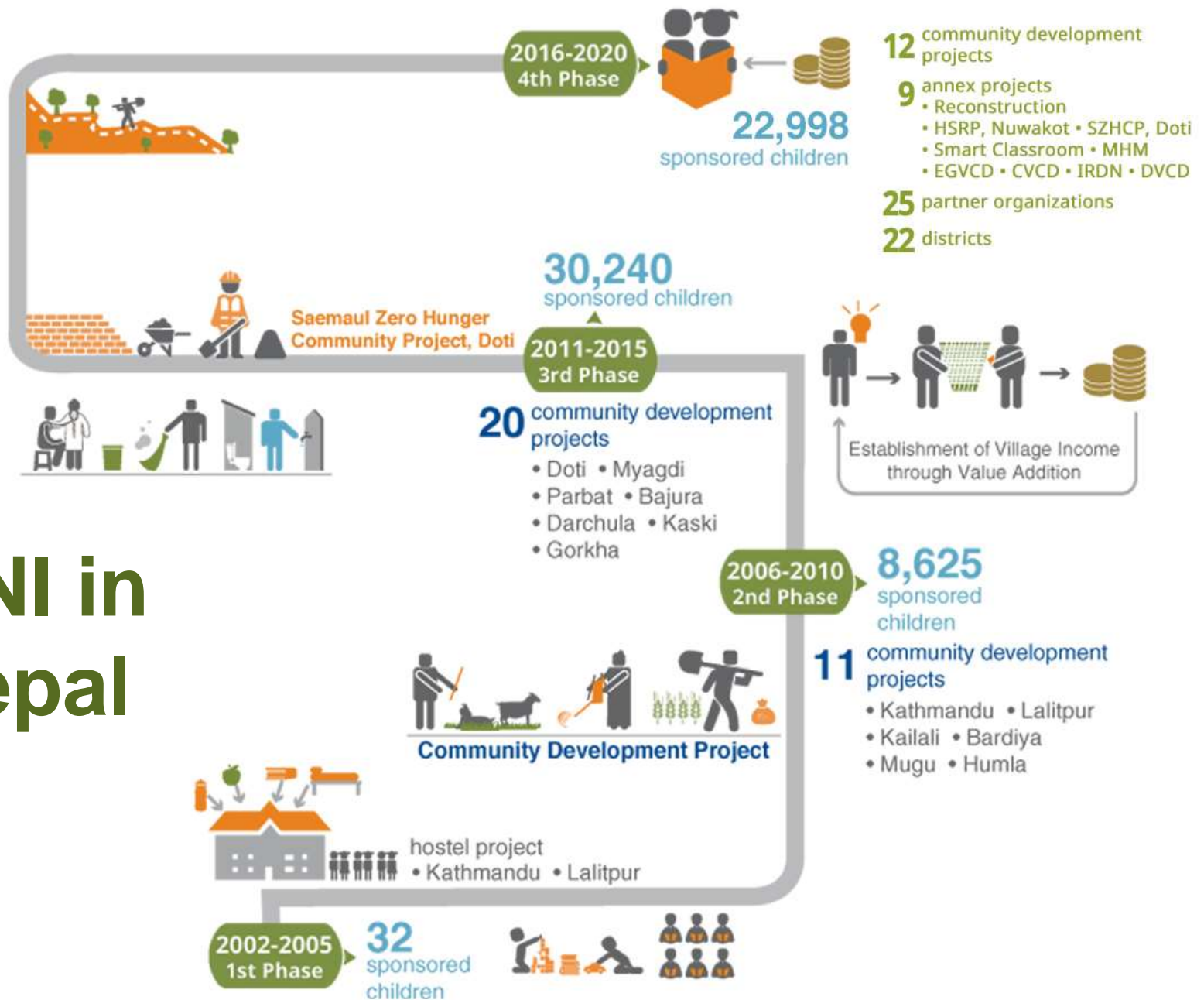

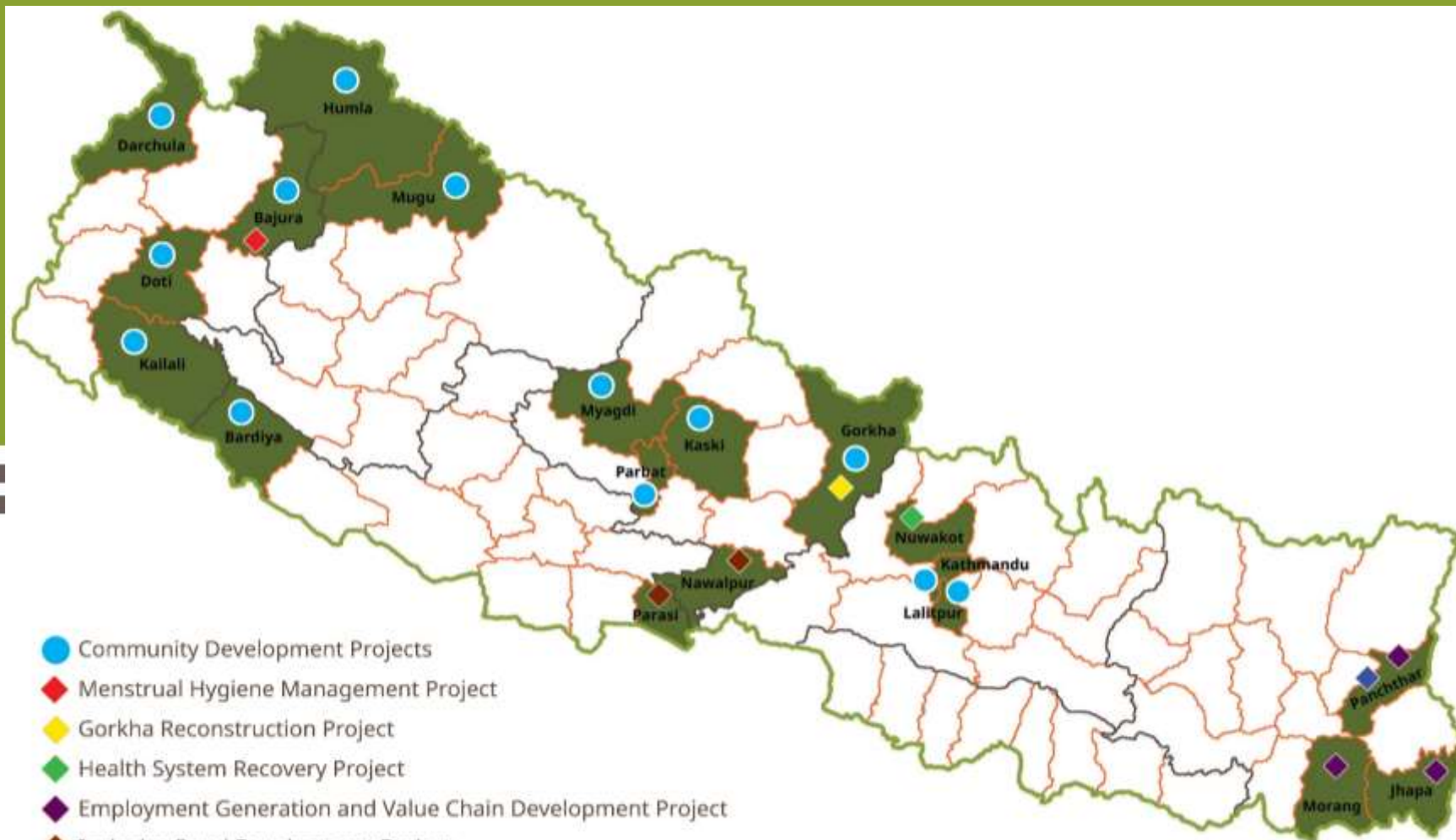

GNI Introduction

- GNI has been working in Nepal since 2002.
- Implementing projects in one metropolis, 21 municipalities and 29 rural municipalities of 19 districts.
- Target Beneficiaries:
 - ▣ 20,828 Sponsored Children (boys – 9,393 and girls – 11,435) and their parents;
 - ▣ 459 schools
 - ▣ 282 Health Facilities
 - ▣ 114 Cooperatives
 - ▣ 194 Child Clubs
 - ▣ 89,529 females and 69,024 males benefited

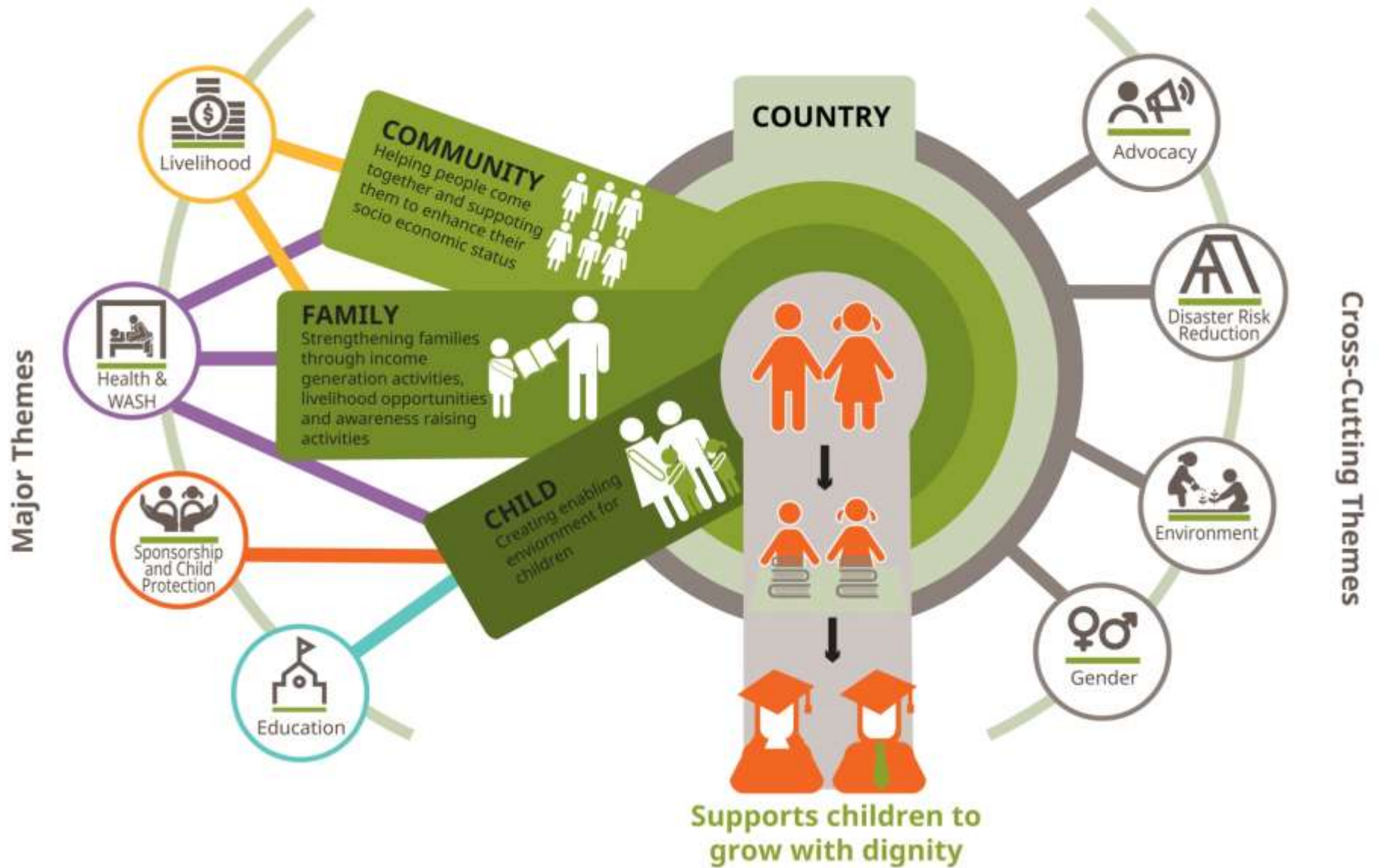

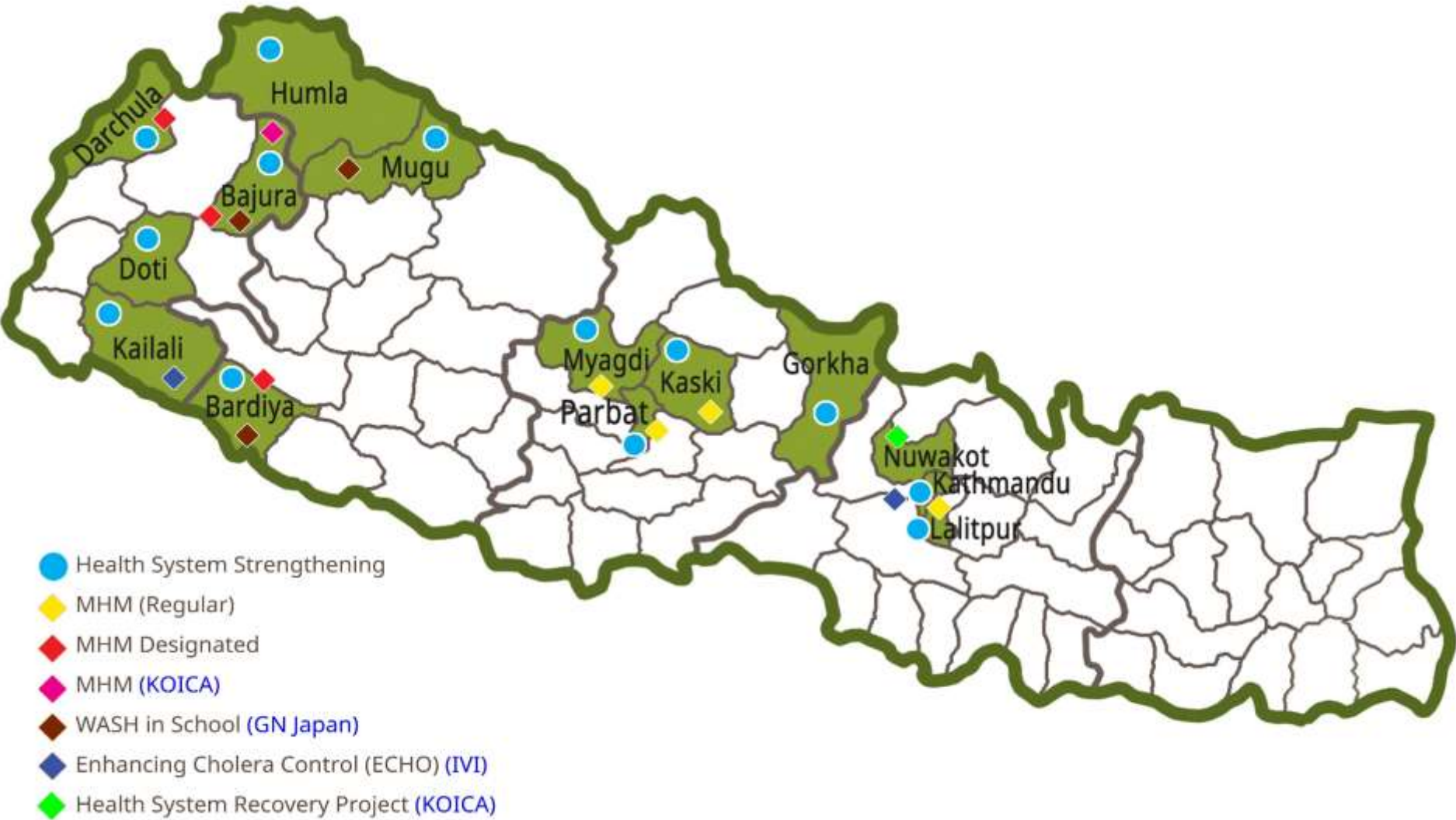

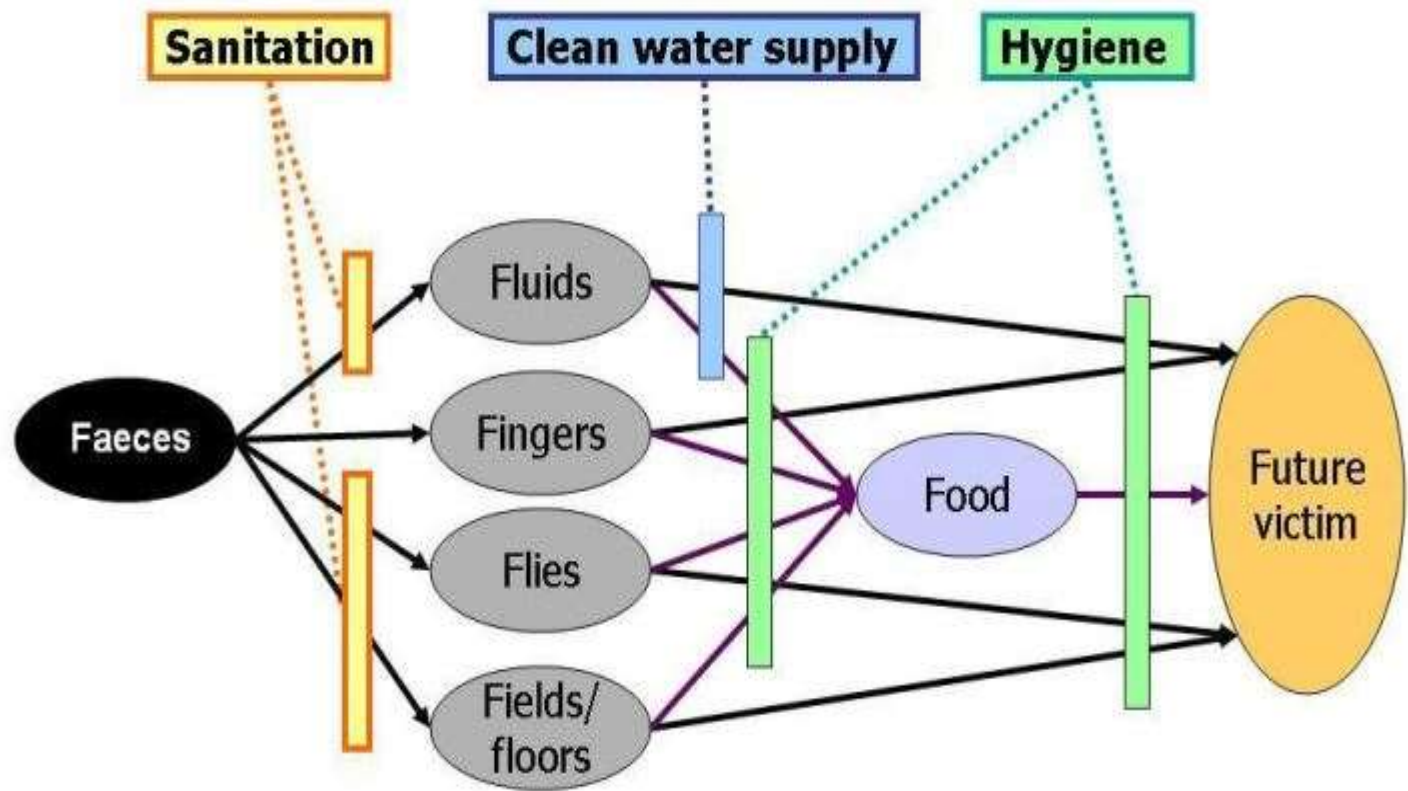
The Seven Essential Elements of WinS
