#### Major Highlights/Achievements

- Palika level Nutrition program review meeting is ongoing.
- National Vitamin A campaign has successfully completed using with IEC materials and Precautionary measures (wearing mask, hand hygiene and maintaining physical distance) were applied. Data is on the compilation process
- Palika level CNSI training is ongoing in District and Palika level in some district. CNSI Training is planned in Dadeldhura, Darchula and Kailali District
- 5 of SAM cases are admitted in 3 NRHs of Province and 47 of SAM cases are admitted in OTCs
- All 3 NRHs and 132 OTCs are fully functional
- Super cereal has been sent to Palika from health Office
  Conducting district level IMAM TOT in Doti, technical support by Suaahara
- With the support from UNICEF and SUAAHARA, nutrition BCC messages are been aired in three different languages (Nepali, Doteli and Tharu) regularly from different 31 Local FMs of the province covering all districts of the province.
- This two-week total **8,718** (**Total 5,61,179 HHs**) Households are counselled by SUAAHARA front line worker and Health Facilities counselling done by SUAAHARA technical officers for support to reviving the services.
- UNICEF and SUAAHARA team regularly supporting for nutrition program implementation.

## Major Highlights/Achievements

- Regular phone follow-up by Suaahara field team and NRH to SAM children HHs.
- Suaahara team is coordinating with Health office and Palika for conduct CNSI training.

- Increasing the COVID-19 infected rate so affect in service delivery

- Plan to distribute super cereal to pregnant women, lactating mothers and U5 yrs children in coordination with Palika Health Coordinators.
- Plan conduct province level IMAM MTOT
- Plan to Province level MSNP ToT.
- Palika planning to distribute super cereal to target group
