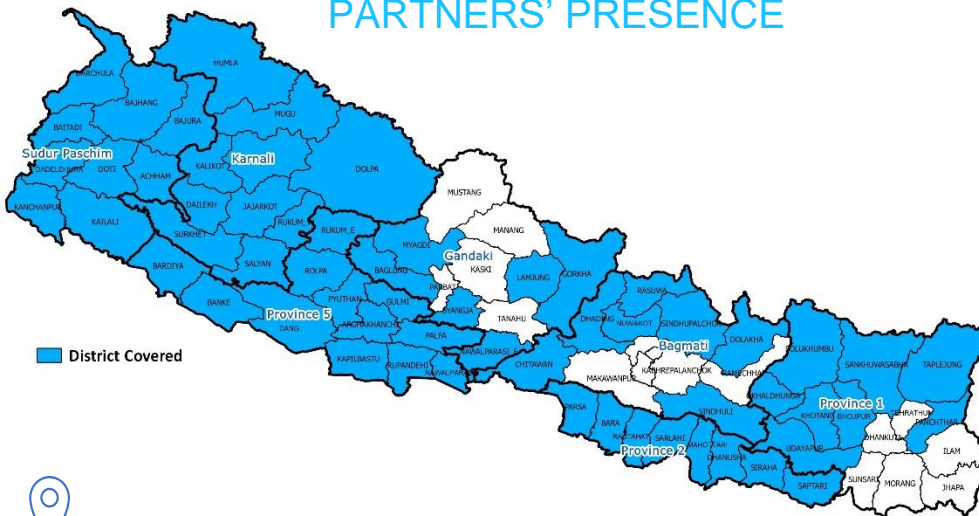

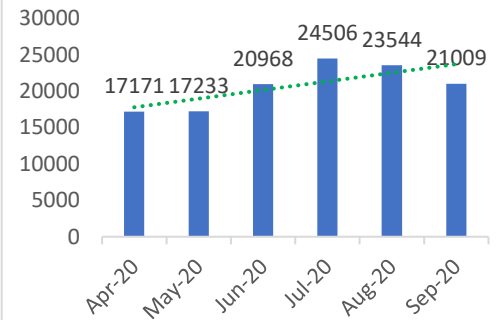

143,514 6-23 months children received supercereal plus

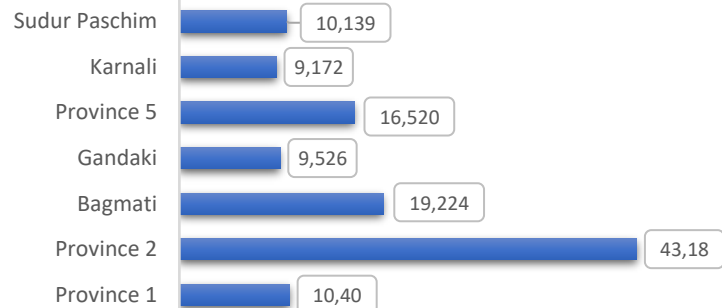


84,839 pregnant and lactating women received supercereal plus
